El Centro Family Health is a private 501 (c) (3) not-for-profit health services organization. El Centro has 16 medical clinics including 2 school-based clinics, 3 dental clinics, and 2 behavioral health clinics including 1 school-based clinic. Our health care services span 22,000 square miles of mountainous rural Northern New Mexico, serving more than 17,500 patients each year in 67,897 encounters, including 2,200 veterans.

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Top Five Goals Met in Quarter 3 2009

1. Applied for grant funding for Semillas de Salud from Con Alma, Daniels Fund, ENMR Nuestro Vecino, and McCune Foundation.
2. Developing plan for Electronic Health Records Integration and Implementation Project. Began work on grant opportunities and applications.
3. Semillas de Salud collaborative efforts with statewide pipelines, local school systems, as well as student rotations programs.
4. Applied for and received Capital Improvement Program grant funding through the ARRA. Grant funding was requested for equipment and a renovation project.
5. Applied for Facility Investment Program grant funding through the ARRA.

Top Five Goals For Q4 2009

1. Developing a Community Health Worker (CHW) program to work with families and individuals in communities providing health education, case management, and providing information for food and transportation.
2. Work together with other Community Health Centers and the New Mexico Primary Care Association to create a certification and licensing program for CHW's. This is a 2-3 year project.
3. Move Health Programs offices to the new Rio Arriba Health Commons facilities.
4. MammoVan, Diabetes Eye Van and Health Fiesta events in Las Vegas.
5. Prepare for flu season with regular flu immunizations and H1N1 flu immunizations.

Quarter 3 2009 in Brief

ECFH applied for and received CIP (Capital Improvement Program) Recovery Act funding. This grant funding will pay for much-needed upgrades in telecommunications equipment and preparatory equipment for Electronic Health Records, and for Phase II of the Las Vegas medical facilities remodel. This remodel will provide space for behavioral health.

ECFH also applied for the final, highly competitive round of ARRA grant funding for the FIP (Facility Investment Program). If approved, this funding will provide the means to complete Phase III of the Las Vegas medical facilities remodel, for the third wing, providing space for our dental clinic. The second project will renovate the Espanola medical facilities, once they have moved to the new Rio Arriba Health Commons in of 2010. By renovating we will provide space for Administrative offices and save \$45K per year in rent.

We are collectively working on local awareness events as well as fundraising events. A Health Fiesta is in the planning for las Vegas clinic and a bowl-a-thon is planned for westside - please join us! Information will be forthcoming.

In light of the current economic crisis, ECFH is working to increase efficiency, reduce costs and raise community awareness about Community Health Centers. Measures we are taking include cross training CHW's and Medical Assistants and researching the integration and implementation of Electronic Health Records, both of which will reduce costs and increase efficiency in patient workflow.

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Support

The rise in health care costs creates great hardship for service organizations like El Centro Family Health. Primary support is provided by federal and state grant funding and patient billing (which we are proud to show 98% claims collection on).
