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General Information

El Centro Family Health is a private 501 (c) (3) not for profit health services organization. El Centro has 16 medical clinics including 3 school-based clinics, 3 dental clinics, and 2 behavioral health clinics including 1 school-based clinic. Our health care facilities span 22,000 square miles of mountainous rural Northern New Mexico, serving more than 17,500 patients each year, including 2,200 veterans.

Patient Demographics

El Centro Family Health serves all income levels, takes most insurances, including Medicaid, Medicare, and VA, and does not turn anyone away for health care, regardless of their income level. Of our 17,552 patients:

- 43% are uninsured
- 88% are under the 100% poverty level
- 22% have Medicaid coverage, and
- 14% have Medicare coverage

Support

Primary support for El Centro Family Health services is provided by federal and state grant funding. Health costs are staggering, and additional funding is procured through private grants and fundraising.

The rise in health costs creates great hardship for service organizations like El Centro Family Health. We need continual support from our leadership and legislature to meet the rising health needs of the constituencies we serve.
