El Centro Family Health is a private 501 (c) (3) not-for-profit health services organization. El Centro has 16 medical clinics including 2 school-based clinics, 3 dental clinics, and 2 behavioral health clinics including 1 school-based clinic. Our health care services span 22,000 square miles of mountainous rural Northern New Mexico, serving more than 17,500 patients each year in 67,897 encounters, including 2,200 veterans.

EL CENTRO FAMILY HEALTH
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Top Five Goals Met in Quarter 1 2009

1. Behavioral Health Expansion Grant successfully submitted.
2. Worked closely with Mayor Chavez (Springer), house representatives, legislators and speakers to secure appropriations.
3. Successfully submitted Increased Demand for Services grant, and researched EHR grant opportunities through the ARRA.
4. Website updated; donor and foundation mailing completed; numerous advertising and marketing pieces developed and employed
5. Walk-through completed at Rio Arriba Health Commons; preparing to move Health Education to the new location.

Top Five Goals For Q2 2009

1. Apply for funds as ARRA grants become available for equipment and/or construction, renovation projects
2. Determine legislative funding allocations and appropriations for LV Dental/Consejos, Rio Arriba Health Commons and Springer.
3. Develop Eastside and Westside promotions program for FY 2010
4. Continue developing Planning and Development plan including fundraising, grants and other activities for the year.
5. 100% recruitment goal. Eastside clinics have 100% recruited providers, Westside still in progress. Seeking to fill positions from IDS funding as well as 2 dentists and 2 dental hygienists.

Quarter 2 2009 in Brief

After a determination that State funding would be cut for FY 2010 at the rate of 11%, the final decision came only weeks ago stating that there would be no decrease in funding for this fiscal year for much needed services such as low income eligible discounts. As the safety net for uninsured, a decrease in funds would have put a serious strain on the budget for 2010.

ECFH applied for and received IDS (Increased Demand for Services) Recovery Act funding. A second grant round is in progress for equipment, construction, renovation and EHR. ECFH is applying for equipment which will prepare us for the next step into Electronic Health Records (EHR) and a renovation project at the Las Vegas clinic which will help us save significantly in our operational budget.

Development for a program to promote services in all clinics is underway. The program will be divided into Eastside and Westside promotions and will include advertising, marketing and promotional activities.

The ECFH Health Programs department is expected to move into the new Rio Arriba Health Commons at the beginning of June. The final contract is currently being negotiated. Building will continue on Phase 2.

After the 2009 State legislative sessions, El Centro is left with numerous unfunded yet critical projects. We will be seeking alternative funding through grants and fundraising for many of these projects.
